Math in the Real World Camp!

"Do you love math? Do you not love math but want to get better at it? Then this is the summer program for you. We will spend three weeks looking at how math applies to real world scenarios, and how to identify and analyze patterns. We will travel outside the building to the Jahn campus, and other surrounding neighborhood locations (TBD) to collect data from the environment around us and see what conclusion we can draw from the data we collect. We will look at real world applications of mathematics and how it is used on a day to day basis, and maybe even develop a math based solution to a problem we see in our community or the larger world around us.
